Abstract

Unices and GNU/Linux are known for their productivity with plenty of small and nifty tools that help get work done in a fast and efficient manner. Sed and awk are two such tools. In this presentation, regular expressions will be reviewed, and the use of sed and awk will be discussed as tools for substitution, with HTML, and HTML to XHTML examples. The usefulness of these tools will be illustrated with column extraction examples, analysis of log messages, and generation of L^AT_EX tables. These will be useful for webmasters, system administrators and desktop users.
